The School for Youth Leadership

The School for Youth Leadership was first opened in March 1992 and is situated on the Central Coast of NSW 1 ½ hours driving distance north of Sydney and 45 minutes driving distance south of Newcastle. It is situated on the edge of Lake Munmorah, giving residents classic views of sunsets over the water. To date 180 young people have been trained at The School for Youth Leadership. Some of these people are now in full time work with The Salvation Army as youth workers, welfare workers, Corps Assistants, church planters, missionaries and Salvation Army Officers.

Facilities

Being a residential school the accommodation, catering and classroom arrangements are all on one site. The School for Youth Leadership also has a library which students may access for further study and reading. The library has a number of computers which students may use to do research and complete assessment tasks.

For recreation students have access to sports equipment supplied by the School for activities both on the lake and the foreshores.



What will it cost?

The course fee for 2012 will be AUD\$6300 which covers course fees/text books/practicum/board and lodging. For your additional spending on personal needs, day off meals, entertainment and outings with other students we suggest AUD\$1000 - \$1500 for the nine months.

Please note: Full payment must be made by the commencement of the course.

Entry Requirements

As this course is “live in” on site at The School for Youth Leadership Lake Munmorah, **you are required to be single or married (without dependants) and between 18 and 28** years of age and;

- You worship on a regular basis at The Salvation Army.
- You live a spiritually healthy life, are committed to God and to the work of The Salvation Army and show an active Christian commitment through your Church.
- You are fluent in, and able to read and write in the English Language (IELTS Level 5.5 - 6).
- Your Corps Officer recommends you for study at the School and would be prepared to complete a backing form.
- You are prepared to live by The Salvation Army ethos and standards whilst attending and representing the SFYL.
- You are ready for one of the most powerful years of your life.
