## **Risen Jesus**

***"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen" Luke 24:5.***

Today we celebrate life! Experience teaches us that death wins and even the strongest succumb to it but the message of Easter is that in Jesus, life gets the last word. Death is real, but it is not final. Jesus is buried after his death on the cross, but death cannot contain him! We are confronted with the amazing and glorious news that the tomb is empty, words that still invoke wonder, joy, and worship of our King.
