Luke was perfectly suited for the work God planned for him. He had an analytical, detailed mind which made him a skilled doctor. It also served him in carefully investigating and writing an accurate account of Jesus' life (the gospel of Luke) and the events of the early church (the book of Acts).

Each of us has been created and fitted by God to fulfill the particular ministry He has chosen specifically for us. We have been placed on this earth not simply to enjoy ourselves, accumulate wealth and achieve prominence, but to serve God. Our responsibility is to respond with obedience to His call.

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10
