Redeem means to buy back, regain possession of, or exchange for money, goods, etc. In Christian theology, redemption refers to the deliverance of Christians from sin.

The Bible makes it clear in Romans 3:23 that every one of us has sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. But not only that, Scripture teaches us that the problem goes much deeper and much further back. We can trace this debt problem all the way back to the Garden of Eden when sin entered the world through one man and all of mankind was affected.

Jesus came into our world to redeem the sinfully bankrupt, the adulterer, the drunkard, the greedy, the idolater, the liar, the prideful, the self-righteous, and every other broken person who turns to Him in faith.

So when you put your faith in Christ, you must understand that your old sinful self has been crucified with Him at the cross and it is no longer you who live, but it is Christ who lives in you. In other words, Jesus has moved in and has reset your value in the eyes of the Father. When God looks at you and me, He no longer sees bankrupt sinners with no hope. Instead, God sees His Son dwelling inside us and we are fully loved and fully redeemed.
