



Matthew 5:13-16, calls Christians to be salt and light through their good deeds. But what does it actually mean to be the salt and light?

What Jesus is telling his disciples (including us) in this passage, is that they are to offer a new way to live that is not conformed to the destructive, violent and sinful patterns of this world.

To be the light of the world is not to condemn, withdraw or shy away from the world, but to actively pursue the dark places, to willingly enter into places of pain, poverty, injustice, sickness, violence and sin.

The word transform comes to mind when thinking about being salt and light. Our National Vision statement talks about transforming Australia one life at a time with the love of Jesus. This comes from all people who say they are part of The Salvation Army committing to live alongside others who may be experiencing hardship or injustice and loving them and fighting for them if necessary, in order to bring about transformation.
