Intimate - we are called into intimate relationship with God our Father and worship allows us to receive and respond to the incredible love and mercy that God has demonstrated to us.

Spirit Led - the Spirit of God is the central catalyst of worship – the Spirit reveals Jesus to us, who brings us into a knowledge and experience of the Father.

Expectant - we come into worship expectantly because we know that the Spirit is there, and our response is to listen humbly, expecting great things of God.

Transformative - we come expectantly into worship and come out experiencing life change, submission to God's will, and a renewed heart for bringing the full power of the Gospel to a lost and broken world.

Freedom - as long as we pursue worshipping God in both the Spirit and in truth then there is great freedom in how we worship.

Hospitable - we need to celebrate the diversity of people of different cultures, socio-economic and worship backgrounds, and to help everyone find a place to genuinely express themselves in worship.

Relevant - our worship will continue to evolve as we seek the best way to connect people to God and send them into the world on mission.

Excellence – worship isn't about perfection but giving our very best because it is for God and about God.

Authentic - worship allows us to be honest before God and to come authentically as we are.


Mission table – BARGAINS this Sunday
