Adults and children combined

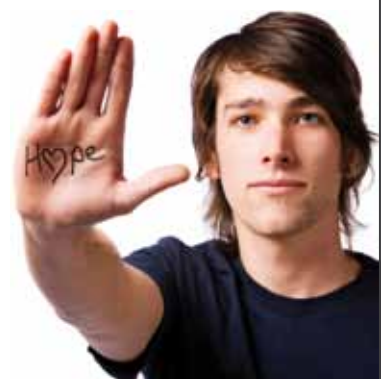
