

Bible Hangman

Aim: To add a little bit of biblical teaching into a simple game.

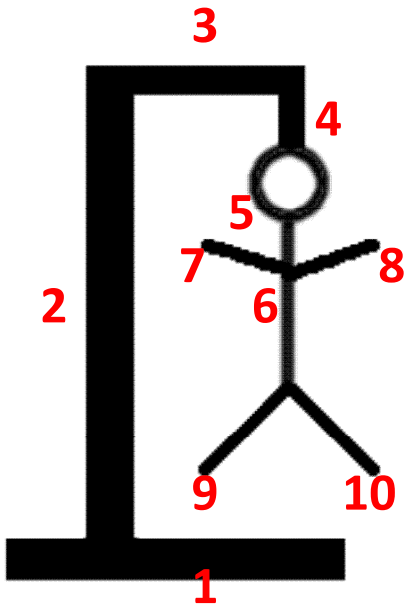
What: Regular hangman, only using Bible verse addresses, entire bible verses, bible characters or Christian things.

How: One person decides what the word or phrase is going to be & draws a line to go under each letter without writing the letters. Leave a space between the lines where there is to be a space between the words. The group then begins to guess letters one at a time. When they get a letter right, the letter is written in all of the places where that letter belongs. If a letter is guessed incorrectly, the next appropriate thing is added to the picture & the letter is written in the used letters space. The group is allowed to guess what the word or phrase is before they get all of the letters but this still counts as a normal guess & penalties apply if incorrect. Once the picture is completed, the person is considered to be hung & the group lose. If the group guess the word correctly, the group wins & nominate another person (usually the person who guesses the final letter or guesses the word first) to go next.

Who: For all ages.

Resource: Paper/whiteboard/blackboard, pen/whiteboard marker/chalk.
