Gospel Chatterbox


Aim: To point children towards reading the message of the Gospel in a fun way.


What: The Gospel chatterbox, just like any regular chatterbox, is a fun way to reinforce concepts as well as engage learners in a visual manner, getting them excited about what their outcome may be. In this case, the chatterbox points the participant towards reading a particular Bible verse. Once this verse has been read, make a point of it to talk about it in further depth depending on the age of the group you're teaching.

Who: Ideal for children's ministries or small group youth meetings.

Resource: A4 paper, pen, scissors.

- 1. Print and cut around outside of Gospel Chatterbox.
- 2. Fold in half & in half again.
- 3. Open out, turn over so top is blank & fold each corner into the middle.
- 4. Turn over & repeat so the numbers are folded into the middle.
- 5. Turn over so you can see the Gospel names.
- 6. Slide your thumb & your finger behind 2 of the names & press together so they bend around and touch.
- 7. Turn over & repeat with the thumb & finger of the other hand for the other two names.
- 8. All the names should now be at the front with centres touching & you are ready to use your Gospel chatterbox!





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
