

COURSE STRUCTURE

Full time students will study to complete 16 units (11 Core Units and 5 Electives) over a period of 9 months. Your training will be delivered through 5 weekend training blocks, fortnightly lectures, site visits, role plays, training workshops, video tutorials, online resources, class work, homework and assignments. The course will require an average of 24 curriculum hours per week.

Additionally you will undertake at least 128 hours of work placement in a youth specific work placement where you will keep a journal to record and reflect on your experiences.

The course is divided into four main focus areas. (See table below):
