

Inner Pyrotechnics: Anger Management Program (young people aged 12 to 25 years).

Inner Pyrotechnics

Inner Pyrotechnics anger management program has been designed to help young people aged between 12 – 25 effectively deal with anger and avoid the negative and destructive consequences that often occur.

The program identifies the triggers and self-talk that leads to aggression and violence, and teaches techniques to manage anger in a positive way.

Entry into the program

The program operates by referral either through self-referral or agency referral.

Target groups include young people experiencing anger problems at home, in school, or with peers, and those in trouble with the police and judicial system.

How does the program work?

Inner Pyrotechnics is a five session program typically run in one hour sessions over five weeks.

The program covers topics like self-awareness, making positive choices, emotions and how we can respond to them, positive communication, triggers, self-responsibility, behaviours and why we do what we do.

Each session is designed to help young people learn skills and knowledge around understanding themselves better. This can help lead to better choices which will lead to more positive outcomes.

Inner Pyrotechnics is about empowerment through increased knowledge, skills and self-control.

How do we work with you?

Inner Pyrotechnics is delivered in two ways: in a one-on-one setting through casework, or by small group participation.

What you can expect

Youth workers at Oasis Hunter have agreed to adhere to the Youth Work Code of Ethics.
