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# SESSION ONE **The Power of Story**

## **OBJECTIVE**

To enable participants to see the power of story in the shaping of their lives. To understand the Gospel, the good news story, and how it is intended to shape life.

## **OPENING EXERCISE**

### 1. IDENTIFYING MY STORY

'I understand scripture?'

What influenced your answer? Where did you get that from?

Listen to yourself - What shaped your response?

Listen to your response to the above question and look to identify what the shaping story is to your answer, why did I answer the way I did?

### 2. CHANGING MY STORY

With new stimulation, new encounters, healing or truth comes the opportunity to change your story.

## **SCRIPTURE**

“My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.” (John 10:27)

“When he, the Spirit of truth, has come, he will guide you into all truth.” (John 16:13)

“The word of God is alive and active...it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.” (Hebrews 4:12)

Scripture says: "Yes, I can understand it." WHY? Because of His presence. It's not because I am smart, but because he is with me, because the word speaks to me.

3. ACTIVATE NEW STORY – RRBR

4. ENGAGEMENT TOOL - SOAP (see appendix A)

**THE POWER OF STORY**

You live life from your story, you are a living, unfolding story.

You respond to stimulus, situations, questions, and our responses shape our stories.

*"All of life is a story"* Madeleine L'Engle

Shakespeare - *"Be aware of the story you tell yourself for you will surely be lived by them."*

Proverbs *"as a man thinks in his heart, so he acts."*

Jesus invites us to take responsibility for our stories. The victory of the cross is the victory of choice, the challenge of the cross is responsibility.

Jesus said - *"I have come that you may have abundant life."* (John 10:10)

Ephesians 1:12 *"Long before we heard of Christ and got our hopes up, he had his eye on us, had designs on us for glorious living, part of the overall purpose he is working out in everything and everyone."*

HOW??? - If Jesus was successful how do I get my hands on his promise of abundant life?

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What else did Jesus say in the same breath?

There is another, *"a thief who will steal, kill, destroy."* (John 10:10)

HOW??? - How does the thief do his thieving?

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Passionate intention + bad story = Frustrated life.

On the whole do you think you are living an abundant life?

Where not? Why?

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Jesus has come to reshape every story we are living from so that he can write an abundant life story in every arena and circumstance of your life. Our circumstances are NOT what is important, our stories are.

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God has moved... We must now move.

Jesus spoke more about the Kingdom of God than any other subject. (mentions Kingdom 72 occasions.)

*“Once you lose the Kingdom theme that is central to the gospels, everything else becomes reinterpreted in ways that radically distort, that substitute, a subtle different gospel message.”*

(N.T. Wright – When God became King)

The SHAPE of our story is a rescue story.

In order to live in a rescue story then you need to know how rescue stories are written.

3 parts to any rescue story FROM – THROUGH – TO

COLOSSIANS 1:21-22

**FROM**

*Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behaviour.*

**THROUGH**

*But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death.*

**TO**

*To present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation.*

Rescue is all over scripture:

If you are living from a rescue story then what part of the story do you live in?

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If you want to live in the abundant life that Jesus came to give then you need to live from the story of the Kingdom. The enemy who wants to steal, kill and destroy the story wants you to live under the influence of his kingdom.

Every decision/story I write will be written under the influence of one of the two kingdoms.

How do you write into your life the abundant life Jesus promised?

1. Self-awareness

*“We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.” 2 Corinthians 10:5*

2. Renew your mind

*“Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is---his good, pleasing and perfect will.” Romans 12:2*

To enable participants to understand their ‘righteousness’ story. And to be healed and equipped to stand and live upon its foundation.

### THE WORLD’S ACCEPTANCE STORY

The world understands being acceptable to God from the framework of earn and deserve / law and punishment.

The world’s story for receiving is based on what I must do.

- no free lunches
- you get what you deserve
- if you want it you must work for it
- it’s up to you

The best known bad news story.... "If I came to your church the roof would fall in."

You must pass the 'good enough' test.

What mark must I get in order to pass? \_\_\_\_\_

If you want to behave well enough to get in God's good books you need to be PERFECT, anything less is FAIL.

If you want to behave good enough for God then you have to be perfect always. And not just in the way you behave but the way that you think. *"If a man lusts after another woman in his heart he has commuted adultery."*

Is this good news???

Why did God give us His laws? How do I understand law in the context of scripture?

Romans 5:20 *"the law was brought in so that the trespass might increase."* (NIV)

Romans 5:20 *"God's law was given so that all people could see how sinful they are."* (NLT)

It wasn't so that we would follow them, it was so that we would \_\_\_\_\_

The law does not make me good (never intended to); it reflects my condition, sinner, and my need for a saviour/rescuer.

Prodigal son (Luke 15:11) - what story will you live from?

**WHAT ABOUT FAITH?**

Where does the role of faith fit in the rescue story?

*"For it is by grace you have been saved through faith." (Ephesians 2:8)*

What is wrong with: Jesus + faith = right with God?

R.T Kendall (The unfailing love of Jesus):

*"Saving faith is when you transfer all the trust you had in yourself to what Jesus has done for you."*

BUT, BUT, BUT....

James 2 *"faith without works is dead."*

How do we understand what James is saying here?

You can't be in the Kingdom and not influenced by it.

When the King declares your righteousness it will produce Kingdom likeness.

Problem - man wants to legislate what this looks like.

**CONCLUSION:**

I will live by this story.

I choose by faith to know myself as completely right with God, welcome in His presence always.

I will not rely on my feelings to speak this truth, I will renew my mind by faith and allow my feelings to catch up. Holy Spirit if I need healing in my past that has established in my life any story that challenges this truth then I receive your leading to my complete freedom.

**HEAVEN'S LOVE STORY**

We come to the King and we say - "*do you love me?*"

He says - "*YES*"

And we ask - "*why?*"

(The world's story has taught us that love has a why? It must BEcaused.)

The King says - "*No why?*"

And we argue and demand to know why. In order to be loved I must do the things that cause love, there is always a why!!!!

We say to God - "*Tell me why you love me so I can arouse you to love me more.*"

When I know why, then I can calculate love, I can make love happen.

But Heaven’s love story has no cause – it is

***Loved without Cause***

God is love, he doesn't DO love, he is not CAUSED to love, he does not love as a response to stimulus, love is the essential nature of who he is.

NO WHY = NO NEED to stimulate.

When you are loved without cause then all that is left is to BE loved.

And that is what God calls you – “His BEloved.”

You are not powerful enough to change God. If God stopped loving you he would cease to be God!

Give up and get loved.

To be in the Kingdom of God is to BEloved.

*“The disciple who Jesus loved.”*

**HOW LOVED AM I?**

1. NO SEPARATION – Romans 8:35-39

2. THE FATHER LOVES ME AS HE LOVED JESUS

John 17:23 (NIV) *“Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.”*

**(NOTE:** Meditate on latter. In appendix C is a love letter from the Father to you. Use this to allow the Father to speak his love into your thinking and over your life.)

**The love of the Father.**

Our view of God the Father is often filtered through your view of your earthly father. Experiences of your earthly fathers can have an impact on the way we are able to receive the Love of our heavenly Father. In appendix B is a list of father types. It may be helpful to identify the type of father you experienced and allow Holy Spirit to lead you in healing so as you can receive the fullness of the love of your heavenly Father.

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## SESSION FOUR **My Forgiveness Story**

### OBJECTIVE

For participants to understand their forgiveness story and live free from shame and condemnation.

### OPENING EXERCISE:

“I live from a story of shame and feel the weight of shame and condemnation.”

### THE WORLD’S STORY OF FORGIVENESS:

We often interpret our forgiveness story from a shaping story that God has forgiveness and I need to come and get it from him when I need it (which is often). The world shapes this story by making us believe that we must ‘beg’, show remorse, ‘pay for’, manipulate God, or at least earn from Him, the release of His forgiveness.

### HEAVENS FORGIVENESS STORY:

## **Forgiven before I ask.**

Our forgiveness story is not shaped by “please, and I will never do it again.” It is shaped by “thank you.”

We don’t ask for that which is already ours. Forgiveness was released 2000 years ago, it is my forever story.

### WHAT ABOUT REPENTANCE?

We repent because we are forgiven NOT so that we will be forgiven. Repentance changes my mind, I do no longer want my life to be shaped by the story that produced that behaviour. Repentance moves me not God.

Luke 23:44 *“It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon.”*  
Sin of all ages gathered at the cross.

**NOTES:**

**APPENDIX A:****SOAP - Having your life read by the word of God.**

Sometimes the word of God brings revelation of new insights into your circumstances, your life, your identity. At other times it brings reminders as to your truth.

Read a passage of scripture and ask the following questions of Holy Spirit.

**S = Scripture:**

Listen for the verse or the theme that Holy Spirit wants to speak to you about. It will capture your interest or just stand out.

**O = Observation:**

Listen to Holy Spirit for what he wants to show you or teach you.

**A = Application:**

How does this relate to your life? What do you do with this? What does Holy Spirit want to reveal to you about how to shape your life based on what he is revealing?

**P = Prayer *RRBRR*:**

Take what has been revealed and form a prayer that may include –

*Repentance*

Changing your mind based on what has been revealed.

*Renouncing*

Taking back agreements that you have made that you see are not in line with what has been revealed.

*Breaking*

Breaking off your life (mind/body/emotions/generational lines) thoughts and actions that you see now are not of God's design.

This is done in the name of Jesus.

*Renew your mind*

Renewing your story for life in the truth that has been revealed

*Rave/Praise*

Giving thanks for what has been revealed and the life it brings.

**APPENDIX B:****FATHER TYPES**

1. **Absent father** – Not present when growing up. This may be due to death, divorce, work, other priorities, etc. Can result in feelings of rejection and abandonment. You may have trouble trusting that God will be there for you. He may feel distant and uninvolved. You may feel like in your spiritual walk you have to make it on your own, and you may have made a vow to make it on your own. We feel that God will not come through, be there, so we strive to get loved, noticed and approved. Or you may keep your distance from God as he may abandon you as your earthly father did.
2. **Passive father** – Is not responsive or involved. He is unemotional or withdrawn. He is there but not there, he does other things. Rarely gives affection or pursues you, he is emotionally withdrawn. It is not that he does not feel he just does not know how to show it. This can result in hidden anger and difficulties in getting in touch with our own emotions or receiving love. Passive father does not know how to protect their children so we can think that God can't protect us. Emotional connectedness with God can be difficult, you know he is about but you have trouble connecting with His presence.
3. **Performance orientated father** – Has high standards not balanced by enough love. Points to faults and failures, if there are all A's but one C on the report card, all attention is on the C. More interested in performance than relationship, and your performance is never good enough. Love and affirmation is only expressed in reference to your performance. You feel like you can never do anything, or enough, right. You can feel that you are never enough in Gods eyes, and your performance to be loved is tiresome and you often feel burnt out. You strive for God the Father to notice your worth and be accepted.
4. **Authoritarian father** – Is strict and lives by the rules. Obedience is valued above relationship. The authoritarian father is impossible to please, and this creates hurt, anger and loss of motivation. You see God as the policeman in the sky with the stick waiting for you to stuff up, so relationship with Him is hard. You feel more often like you are in trouble rather than His desire. We think all that interests Father God is our obedience to the rules.
5. **Abusive father** – He inflicts physical, emotional, verbal or sexual abuse upon the family. This creates great inner pain, fear and insecurity. The house is full of fear, and this is the father you hide from. Often children feel like the abuse is their fault and feel like they are the cause and to blame. The atmosphere in the home is charged with shame, pain and hurt. And kids grow up with guilt and worthlessness. When it comes to God the Father you never know where you stand, you may view God as harsh, he may punish or harm you. You don't want to get close because dads hurt you, you live afraid of God. We may also feel anger towards God because he did not protect you.
6. **The Good father** – Unconditionally pours out love, affirmation and encouragement in concrete ways, even in discipline. He is proud of you and initiates relationship. He still needs to point us to God as the only perfect father.
