Kibera Slum Nursery School

Kibera nursery school is not less than an Oasis in the Kibera slum, probably the second largest in the world, and certainly the biggest of all Africa.

This place offers children a caring environment where they receive a basic education and 3 meals a day, 6 days a week.

80 pupils attend this school from 3 to 6 years of age, including a baby class of 20 pupils aged 3 and 4.

The nursery school is located in the Kibera compound which has a Corps and a community Hall, and it is just minutes away from Nairobi downtown, the capital city of Kenya.

Like all other centres in Kenya, the biggest struggle for this centre is the funding for the feeding program, which they manage to cover with the small fees they charge at the

school and with overseas donations. Their strategy is to provide children a basic menu which consists mainly of maize and beans; so by buying the cheapest ingredients they are able to stretch their budget. Their meals are not balanced, nor nutritious; but they are filling.

The conditions in the slums are very precarious for most families. With the need to pay rent even for shacks, they are left with little choice to buy food. That is why it means so much for parents to have their children enrolled at the school, because at least the little ones can have food 6 days a week.

There are instances where small children keep some of their food to share with siblings at home, as it is a very common thing to hear of children that go without food for days.
