Ndlavela Crèche

Ndlavela crèche is a small day care centre in Maputo, the capital city of Mozambique. The centre is directly linked to The Corps of the same name and it serves its local community.

Currently it has 37 pupils, boys and girls between the ages of 3 and 6. The Corps was recently rebuilt, and it now serves as the church hall and the crèche room.

The facilities of the crèche are very basic:

There is only one room where all children receive their classes together; a nursery which needs fixing, and a toilet.

There is no kitchen, no teaching equipment, educational toys or books.

Children receive their lessons in the form of songs, and practice their ABC writing it on the dirt floor just outside the classroom.

A normal day at the crèche starts at 7am when the children arrive. They are given breakfast, do their exercise and have some classes until midday. Then it's lunch time, then afternoon nap, and right before they go at 3pm they are given afternoon tea.

The Ndlavela community benefits greatly from the programs established by the Corps...and there is a lot of potential of what could be done in this place.
