




CHRISTMAS DAY COLLECTION




NEW DISASTER recovery partnership Woolworths & The Salvation Army

Final edition of Pipeline Magazine heralds a new chapter PIPELINE SUBSCRIPTIONS

As part of the move to one National Territory, *Pipeline* - the internal magazine of the Australia Eastern Territory - is to be retired. The December issue of *Pipeline* is the final edition of the magazine. The Australia Eastern Territory editorial team has begun the transition to a new-look National Editorial Department. From that department will come a new national internal magazine, due for launch in February 2017.

This new publication will continue to carry key messages from our leaders to Salvationists and others associated with The Salvation Army across Australia. It will continue to present feature articles, stories of transformation, profiles of Salvation Army mission and ministry, opinion writing, theological pieces, culture writing, and news from corps and centres around the country.

So, what does this mean for your corps/centre subscription to *Pipeline?* Nothing! Your subscription will automatically carry over to the new national magazine. There will also be a reduction in the cover price, from \$3 (*Pipeline*) to \$2 per copy for the new magazine.


