Self Denial Altar Service 6th May Leaving a Legacy

While chatting over coffee this week I enjoyed a conversation on the positive impact of older generations speaking into younger people. My companion shared the influence upon his children and I reflected on some older men who impacted my own life while I was just a teenager. Every Sunday these men would make a point to welcome me to worship, inquire of activities, and speak faith and hope into my circumstances. It just so happens that these men were high achieving Officers but their legacy was not in the programs they had initiated but in the person they were to me. This pastoral coffee was a God moment to remember the encouragement and challenge given by Steph last Sunday to do 3 simple things with the young people in our corps:

- 1. Never let them feel they are alone
- 2. Invest in them in small wavs
- 3. Show Jesus to them

Long after they have gone I can still tell you the names of the older men in my corps who did this for me. They took an interest, gave encouragement, spoke faith and hope and let me see Jesus in the way they lived and acted. The years may have passed but their legacy lives on and I'm now trying to leave a similar mark on the young people around me. If we who are older will serve God in this way then the legacy of faith and Salvationism will be strong and long. Will you do it?
