



VOLUNTEER GUITAR TEACHER WANTED!

Located in Surry Hills, Oasis Youth Support Network is The Salvation Army's response to youth homelessness in Sydney's inner city.

We are looking for an engaging volunteer who can provide **guitar lessons** in our studio one afternoon each week for our young people as part of the StreetMedia Program. StreetMedia is our creative arts, training and development program that provides young people with a fun, creative outlet for self-expression through a variety of mediums such as music, art, film, radio, photography and theatre. We do ask for a minimum of two to three months commitment from volunteers, however days and times are flexible to fit around their schedule.

Volunteers are not required to have guitar teaching qualifications, however should be proficient players and have some experience teaching guitar. Volunteers also need to be over 21 years of age, be sympathetic to working with vulnerable young people and have the ability to be flexible and creative in new situations.

All volunteers must pass an interview and complete a Working with Children Check before commencing.
