Special Note: CENSUS NIGHT 2016

Tuesday, 9 August 2016 is Census night. Every household in Australia will be required to completed their Census form and provide information about themselves. Completing the Census is compulsory, and the information gathered is used to enable the government to make important decisions about our country's future and how government funds should be distributed.

The census is also a great opportunity for us to give a national platform to the reach and impact of The Salvation Army. To do this effectively I would like to bring your attention to the 'Religious Affiliation' section (Question 18 in online form; or Question 19 in the paper form).

The Salvation Army stands independently as a denomination of the Christian church and is represented in 127 countries worldwide. It is important that The Salvation Army is represented accurately and fairly in the Census. This information will also strengthen the position and influence of the Army so we can continue to advocate for those who need our support.

For those of you who identify as being part of The Salvation Army church, I ask you to please enter this information into the 'Religion Affiliation' section. I have prepared some guidance below to help you record The Salvation Army as your religious affiliation on the census and I ask that you please ensure this guide is also shared with the members of your

To identify as part of the Salvation Army in the 2016 Census please follow these steps:

- 1. The question will ask, "What is the person's religion?", and appears in either:
- Q18 in the online household form; or
- Q19 in the paper household form; or
- Q21 in the online and paper personal forms.
- 2. To answer this question, please write **The Salvation Army** in the 'Other (please specify)' box at the end of possible responses. (Please note that by entering your religion as The Salvation Army in the 'Other (please specify)' box you are still identifying yourself as Christian.)

Your support will enable us to continue to move forward together into the world of the hurting, broken, lonely dispossessed and lost, reaching them by all means with the transforming message of Jesus bringing freedom, hope and life. Thank you.
