Beginning on Monday 24th July, our Corps & our Store is hosting a Year 9 Student Program for 10 students from Quakers Hill High School. The Program is called "Retail Management Experience" and will take place on 4 consecutive Mondays from 24th July to 15th August, from 9am—3pm. It will be conducted in the Young Peoples Hall with a team of volunteers who have their WWCC's. Our young people from the Corps helped design the program and they will be doing the follow-up mentoring after the 4 Mondays have finished.

How does this affect our Corps? In the short term, after each Sunday meeting, we will be setting up the tables and chairs for Monday, and at the end of Monday we will set up the tables and chairs for Home League, the following day. In the long-term, our young people like Carmen, Eliza, Bill and Caitlin will be building relationships with these young year 9 Students and hopefully drawing them into our Corps. Our biggest prayer is that our young people and the Impact program will be able to connect with these students and bring them into a relationship with Jesus.
