Beds - water beds, bed frames with wire bases and bed heads that are not freestanding.		Bed frames with slats. Bed heads that are donated as part of an ensemble are acceptable. Please ensure bedheads are dismantled from bases before pick up as drivers do not carry tools.	
Bed bases – individual bases without a mattress		None.	
Blinds (any internal window coverings supplied with cord adjustments, eg Vertical, Holland, Roman blinds etc. and curtain tracks controlled by cords).		Blinds (internal window coverings) that do not use cords. Brand new blinds supplied with all tensioning devices, warning labels and manufacturers instructions. Curtain tracks without cord controls.	
Bunk beds & Loft beds.		None, unless brand new.	
Building materials eg, sinks, baths, toilets, basins, doors, timber etc.		None.	
Car parts eg, doors, body panels, mechanical parts etc.		None.

Furniture that is broken and incomplete. This includes tables, chairs, wall units book shelves etc.		Items of saleable quality with minor defects.	
Furniture (soft furnishings) that is stained, torn or broken. This includes lounge suites, chairs, rugs, mats, curtains etc.		Items of saleable quality with minor defects.

Infant's nightwear and jumpsuits that are not fire rated.	Fire rated items must have a fire rating tag attached.
Inflatable toys, novelties and furniture containing beads.	None.
Knives, all kitchen, carving, hobby, utility and sporting knives.	Table knives, knives used as part of table cutlery. To purchase these items the customer must be 18+. Proof of age is to be requested if in doubt.
Prams and strollers.	Offer for sale if all the following conditions are met, Standards Australia logo "AS/NZS 2088" is present on the pram. * A compulsory warning label must be attached to the three point harness stating, "Warning: use this harness at all times" * A compulsory warning label must be attached in a prominent position stating, "Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Put on all brakes...etc". * Must have parking brakes AND the brake actuators must be red in colour. * Must have a safety wrist tether/strap that must be as short as possible and not form a loop of more than 360mm. * Have a compulsory warning label attached to the tether strap stating, "Warning: use this strap to stop the pram/stroller rolling away".
Mattresses and/or bases that are unacceptably stained, torn or broken	Mattresses and/or bases that are acceptably clean, not broken and free of tears and holes. Acceptability to be left to staff discretion at time of donation.
Monkey bikes, a small replica of a motor bike usually powered by a petrol engine.	Battery powered ride-on toy motor bikes, capable of speeds around walking pace.
Safety belts and child restraints.	None.
Stuffed animals, real animals that have died and then been preserved (stuffed).	None. This does not include toys.
Swimming Floatation Aids, includes arm bands, attached rings, swimming aid vests. Generally children's pool toys/aids.	A Standards Australia logo "AS 1900-2002" is present on the swimming aid AND a warning label stating "Warning use only under competent supervision" (arm bands & attached rings) or "Warning use only under competent supervision not for use in boating" (swimming aid vest).
Swing sets.	None, unless brand new and still in packaging.
Televisions of CRT (old tube style) or Plasma types.	All LCD or LED televisions are acceptable. All can be offered for sale only after tested and tagged for safety compliance.
Trampolines (playground equipment).	None, unless brand new and still in packaging. Domestic "exercise bouncers".
TV cabinets. Larger television cabinets designed to house older style CRT televisions.	Lowline television cabinets designed for LCD, LED and plasma televisions.
Washing lines.	None, unless brand new and still in packaging.
Weapons, swords, guns, all martial arts weapons, batons.	None.
White Goods eg, fridges (all sizes), freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, dish washers etc.	Any white goods in "GOOD CONDITION" condition and all clothes dryers and bar fridges. All can be offered for sale only after tested and tagged for safety compliance.
