

GENERAL BRIAN PEDDLE TAKES OFFICE AS 21ST INTERNATIONAL LEADER OF THE SALVATION ARMY

GENERAL Brian Peddle has now taken office as The Salvation Army's 21st international leader, succeeding General André Cox, who has retired. He is joined in leading the global Salvation Army by Commissioner Rosalie Peddle (World President of Women's Ministries). Fuelled by their conviction that God continues to use The Salvation Army to impact our world, the General and Commissioner Peddle share a strong sense of calling as Salvation Army officers. They are convinced of their responsibility to preach the gospel, encourage the saints and serve those in need. They fully embrace and celebrate the diversity of The Salvation Army, while sensing deeply the joy of leading an international Army that is unified through its calling to mission.



The IHQ welcome to the new international leaders will take place on Monday 6 August, and the public welcome – which will be live-streamed – will be held at William Booth College, London, on 23 September. Salvationists and friends around the world are asked to support their leaders in prayer now and in the coming days.

WHAT IS THE SALVATION ARMY'S RESPONSE TO THE WORST DROUGHT IN ALMOST 100 YEARS?

The Salvation Army have a long standing legacy providing support in Drought Relief and Rural Support through our Rural Chaplains and have been aware of the plight of drought affected farmers for a long time. NSW, ACT and Qld are now experiencing what has been called as the worst drought in 100 years. In response to this The Salvation Army has released more resources and funding to the front line to help farmers and regional communities affected by the drought. THE SALVATION ARMY IN INDONESIA BEGINS EARTHQUAKE RESPONSE ON LOMBOK

THE Salvation Army in Indonesia is providing medical and other assistance to people who were affected by a series of earthquakes that hit the island of Lombok. The official death toll is reported as 259 people, but provincial officials and local media are reporting that the final number may be closer to 350. According to the government, more than 1,400 people have been injured and at least 156,000 displaced. A 5.9-magnitude earthquake struck on 29 July, followed by 7 and 5.9-magnitude quakes on 5 and 9 August.

An assessment team from The Salvation Army's Indonesia Territorial Headquarters travelled to Lombok and focused its attentions on the area in and around the village of Gangga, in north-west Lombok, which is home to around 1,000 people. Residents said the Salvation Army team was the first to visit the area since the initial earthquake struck.

Plans are being put in place to use medical teams from Salvation Army hospitals to provide healthcare assistance and services. Specially trained staff within the team will also offer mental healthcare and trauma counselling. The Salvation Army is also planning to distribute nutritional support to children, clothing and hygiene items, drinking water and family food parcels. ECUADORIAN YOUTH DELEGATE DONATIONS

Our Fiesta Noche last Saturday evening was a great success. We have now raised over \$5,000 which means we can sponsor 73 of our target of 150 children. Thank you to those who have already made a donation to this project.

There are a number of ways you can support both the apostles travelling to Ecuador, the youth camp being held from 1-4 November and/or The Salvation Army school in Cayambe. The first stage of support we are looking for is to sponsor an Ecuadorian delegate. Each delegate is asked to pay a deposit and the plan is for us to supplement the amount. The cost is USD52 [around AUD70] for each of the 150 campers. This is territory that relies on international support to fund projects [it is one of the places that will be featured in the 2018 Self Denial] and be a viable and vibrant ministry in this part of the world. Envelopes for donations can be found on the fiesta display at the back of the main hall at Granville.
