CHRISTMAS GIFT CARDS

Friends, It seems that the Groceries Only cards are proving difficult to find – although these are the cards that have been recommended. This is what they look like.

FOR IN-STORE PURCHASE:

Woolworths at Winston Hills, Kellyville Plaza and Seven Hills definitely have the 'Groceries Only' cards. **BUT** they are not displayed with the other gift cards. You will need to go to the service desk and ask to purchase one. They will probably be locked away at the desk. Having made the purchase (suggest \$30 or \$50) the worker on the register or service desk will write the value amount on the back of the card.



ALTERNATIVE 1:

The Groceries Only card can be purchased directly on-line from the Woolworths website.

i. Google Online shopping Woolworths ii) look for 'gift cards' to select [along top or side of page] or type Gift Cards in the search dialogue box iii) Click on Woolworths Wish Gift cards iv) Open Tab 'Groceries Gift Cards' and purchase.
